Located in the Northern Region of Brazil, in Pará State.

CLIMATE

The climate of the region is typically equatorial, with high temperatures and strong humidity throughout the year. The rainy season goes from December to May, with heavy rains that ensure the river's high water volume. During this period, the rains may be heavy, which causes the river level to go up and, consequently, the flooding of some areas along its margin. In the rest of the year, the rainfall goes down, but there is still frequent precipitation. Normally in May, the rains stop, thus making the level and turbidity of the river suitable for fly fishing.

CONSERVATION AREA

This conservation area is one of the most pristine in all the Amazon.

In it, you will find neither people nor indigenous people: only the exuberant fauna and flora, besides breathtaking scenery.

We have obtained the 1st license for recreational fishing in this conservation area. As a result, it is a very preserved place, exhibiting animals, dense forest and fish galore, as well as amazing views.

RIO DOS SONHOS

The Rio dos Sonhos presents a natural diversity that amuses the visitors and the amount of fish is impressive, with specimens of *tucunarés*, *trairões*, *cachorras*, *bicudas*, *matrinxãs*, *pacus* and some species of skin fish. A real paradise for recreational anglers within the Amazon rainforest.

The fly angler will face several fishing situations, several different biomes and many different species to fish. Beaches, rocks, rapids, waterfalls, hills are a treat for fishing and having fun.

Navigating in these waters is like diving deep in nature, surrounded by the largest tropical rainforest on the planet. It is a special place to catch and release, take photos, interact with nature and relax.

THE LODGE

Our structure is somewhat high when compared to the ground, protecting it from animals, as if it were a “tree house”, offering a view of the treetops. Projected to offer comfort for groups of up to 8 anglers. It has 04 double bedrooms with private bathrooms overlooking the river; walking past the restaurant, one can see schools of fish by the lodge's dock.

The lodge offers Starlink Wi-Fi service, daily laundry and a private landing strip for airplanes. It was designed and conceived using high-quality materials.

* We do not use electrical motors due to their noise, presenting a more silent approximation of the fishing spot with the use of oars.

** Specialized in fly fishing, thus being able to provide guidance to the clients about the location's fishing techniques. Also, if necessary, they can accompany the anglers for a specific guidance.

TRAVEL PLAN

SATURDAY | ARRIVING AT THE AIRPORT

Arrival in Manaus, where our team will be waiting for you at the airport to take you to your hotel. The first night's accommodation is included in the package. We recommend arriving early to solve any travel problems or issues related to baggage reclaim, in case yours doesn't arrive with you.

SUNDAY | RECEPTION

Breakfast included at the hotel. After the meal, our staff will take you to the airport for the domestic flight to the jungle, scheduled for 7:30 a.m. The ETA is approximately 2 hours and, upon arrival in the jungle, you will be accommodated in your room. In the afternoon, there will be a welcome barbecue, followed by a session to organize your gear, including selecting the items for your backpack and the flies for your box. We'll also spend time practicing your casts and introducing you to the most effective fishing techniques in these local waters. After dinner, rest up for the start of your adventures.

MONDAY TO SATURDAY | DAILY FISHING AND EXPLORING ADVENTURES

Breakfast will be served at 5:30 a.m., and at 6:00 a.m. the quad bikes will be ready to take you to the day's starting point. Together with your fishing partner, you will visit different locations along the river, always with the guidance of an expert guide, who will ensure that you arrive back at the lodge by 5:30 p.m., before nightfall. Each day, you will explore new sections of the river, fishing in fresh and challenging waters. Upon returning to the lodge, dinner will be served, followed by a rest for a new day of fishing.

SUNDAY | RETURNING

Do your check-out and leave your baggage outside your room. Breakfast will be served at 5:30 a.m., and, if you wish, there is the option of a quick fishing session at the lodge's pool. Afterwards, finish organizing your gear and head to the airstrip by 8 o'clock for the return flight to Manaus. During the journey, there will be a stop in Itaituba for refueling before continuing to Manaus. Upon arrival, our staff will take you to the hotel for the last night's accommodation and will organize your shuttle to the airport for your flight home.

Payments must be made to the agency's checking account in an American bank (Olympus Travel Corp.)

PRECAUTIONS SO THAT YOUR TRIP IS PERFECT

For your trip to the Amazon to be accident-free, some precautions are deemed necessary. Risks like insect bites and sunstroke, among others, can be avoided if we are aware and organized during the week.

Any special care must be communicated to our team, like food allergies, use of medications, diabetes etc.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is important to have travel insurance to cover any problems during the trip, like delays and cancellations in airports, lost luggage, fishing gear breaks and hospital expenses.

Buy a travel insurance with your preferred partner before the trip.

NOT RECOMMENDED

Not recommended for individuals with strong allergic reactions to bug bites, with phobia of water or who don't know how to swim, as well as the ones with back problems.

VACCINES

For those not vaccinated, the yellow fever* vaccine is recommended (up to 10 [ten] days prior to the trip).


*which is valid for 10 years





NATURAL RISKS


During your week-long stay at the lodge, you will be in a natural environment, with risks like bites from bugs and other animals.


Although rare, some incidents can happen during your trip, so it is important to be aware of the items below:


Bee stings
 Very common in this area, mainly from June to August; it is important to pack an anti-allergy medication.

Mosquito bites
 They offer no risks, but bother a little. It is important to bring a bug-repellent with Icaridin, long-sleeved clothes and a buff (neck gaiter). They are more frequent in the early morning and at dawn, close to rocks.

Sunstroke
 Because of the daily exposure to the sun, use a lot of sunscreen throughout the day, besides long-sleeved clothes, long pants, sunglasses, cap and buff.

Spiders, snakes and scorpions
 Although rare, it is important to be careful while putting on boots and shoes, besides keeping bags closed in the lodge.

Rainstorms and lightning
 More frequent from October to December.
 Our team is instructed to leave the water in case of rainstorms with lightning.

Stingrays
 It's important to follow the guides' recommendations when wading in the water because there are many stingrays there. Always pay attention when walking backwards to avoid being surprised by these animals, which move slowly and can position themselves behind the angler without him seeing them.

CACHORRA-LARGA | *Hydrolycus scomberoides*

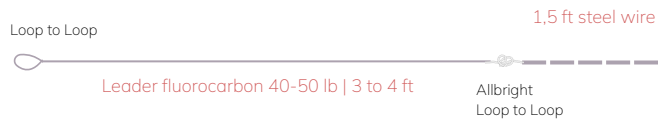
Fishing the *Cachorra Larga* preferably happens in rapids, close to rocks and, occasionally, in the rapids' headwaters. An exclusive differential in our river is the possibility of finding specimens on the surface, in shallow areas, allowing visual fishing. This experience makes the fishing even more involving and pleasant

Flies tied with 2 hooks significantly increase your chances of capture.

Tied in a synthetic material, the flies must be larger and, in some cases, weighted for reaching deeper.

LEADER RECOMMENDATION

Leader in fluorocarbon 40 lb to 50 lb.



STEEL WIRE

Use a 40 lb to 50 lb steel wire while assembling, 1,5 ft long.

** Always carry a spare line - it is common for lines to be damaged by contact with rocks.

** Sinking lines get the best results.



TUCUNARÉ | CICHLA MELANIAE

The Tucunaré can be caught throughout the entire length of the river.

It prefers places with rock structures and beaches, being able to remain in calmer waters and strong rapids.

The most productive fishing happens in the drier months.

LEADER RECOMMENDATION

Leader in fluorocarbon 35 lb to 50 lb.

Loop to Loop



We recommend the use of a flexible steel wire for fishing the tucunaré, in order to avoid cuts in the line caused by species having sharp teeth, like cachorras, trairões and piranhas, that may be accidentally caught.

MATRINXÃ | BRYCON CEPHALUS

They are used to feed close to the riverbanks and in the rapids headwaters. They basically feed on small insects and fish.

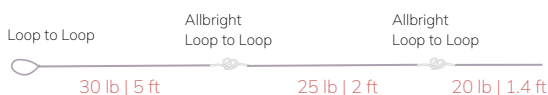

PACU-BORRACHA | *Piaractus mesopotamicus*

Fishing the Pacu-Borracha will happen preferably in regions with faster waters; bases of waterfalls and rapids, close to waters with moderate rapids, where one can find algae most of the year.

Flies mimicking algae and small insects, tied with resistant hooks.

PACU-PRATA | *Myloplus rubripinnis*

The Pacu-Prata prefers to live on the Rio dos Sonhos banks.

Small flies mimicking insects, fruits and flowers, tied with good-resistance hooks.

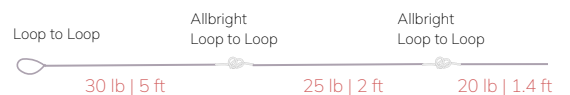
